Lucifer's Sigil and the Meaning of Lucifer

In Sanskrit the L letter is given to Venus relating to the mula chakra, which means the world support, which relates to the entire spine and the kundalini, the serpent energy. Its main sigil is identical to one sigil of Lucifer in the west. Lucifer is the Latin name of Venus. The L letter is Venus. The Latin word for light, Lux, comes from this. The energy of enlightenment of the serpent power.

Note that both relate to the symbol of infinity and the serpent energy. The upward line and the crossing line are the symbol of the union of spirit and matter. Lucifer's sigil is the symbol of the risen serpent going thought the three knots into the crown, giving enlightenment.

In Taoism the highest name of the Dragon is Lung. Lung is the name of the serpent life force in Taoism. However the 'ng' in the eastern languages is simply

a high nasal M sound. This is Lum, the name of the mantra of the root chakra and this becomes Laum fully spelled out.

The L letter in the east also relates to the mountain pathway in the west. Lucifer rules the sacred mountain, it's the spinal column the serpent travels up, and the most ancient images found in China show an icon of a man with a serpent on the back going up into the head. You can find the same in the west in the ancient images found in Greece and such.

The L letter in Sanskrit also relates to water, the symbol of the life force in the west. The L rune also relates to water as well. In the eastern traditions Murrugan, the God of Serpent Power Yoga, is called Venus, or Shukra in Sanskrit. This is also the Yezidi God as the Yezidi elders mention, and their culture shows this. The Yezidis call their God Satan, which is the highest name of God in Sanskrit, known to be the original language.
